



ABOUT HOPE MISSION

Hope Mission is a Christian not-for-profit social care agency caring for men, women, youth and children experiencing poverty across Alberta. In Edmonton, Hope Mission serves over 1000 meals each day, and it provides a safe place to sleep for about 500 people every night.

Hope Mission exists to serve, strengthen and uplift men, women, youth and children through the life-changing gospel of Jesus Christ.

We provide basic and emergency care through our daily meal service and overnight shelters, as well as counsel, referral, and housing services for men, women and youth. Specialized care and treatment is offered through faith-based addiction recovery programs.

Hope Mission reaches out to kids in our community to help encourage positive choices. We provide mentorship through *Kids in Action*, an after school recreation and meal program for children in low-income neighbourhoods in Edmonton, Calgary and Wetaskiwin. Hope Mission also hosts summer camps in northern and southern Alberta for hundreds of inner-city children and youth, and it operates the year-round, drop-in Tegler Youth Centre in Northeast Edmonton.

We operate the *24/7 Rescue Van*, in partnership with EPS and EMS, which provides emergency care for people in need in Edmonton.

Furthermore, Hope Mission's *Hope Bargain Shoppe* provides clients with clothing and other essential items while generating revenue, which directly supports our programs and services.

In all, our desire is to provide compassionate care and offer hope to those experiencing poverty across our province.

Quick facts about Hope Mission:

- Over 1000 meals per day are served out of the Hope Mission kitchen in Edmonton.
- On average 500 people sleep at Hope Mission every night.
- In 2014, we provided over 369,000 meals to the hungry and homeless.
