During the summer, you will prepare and distribute bagged lunches to students in the community.

- Excellent communication skills
- Conflict resolution and verbal de-escalation skills
- Knowledge of resources and supports available for children, youth, and families in Red Deer or willingness to learn

- Standard First Aid certification not required but an asset
